

DAGENHAM PARK SUBJECT CURRICULUM

Subject	Music
Year Group	Year 10 BTEC
Overview	The Music BTEC course is firmly rooted in practical projects that give a rich insight into the music industry. The course is based on practical assessment with a suitable balance of theory and written work.
Autumn Term	Unit 2: Managing a Music Product: Pupils will be actively planning, developing and delivering the school's Christmas Concert. Students will learn how to manage a music event, covering all aspects such as programming, promoting, ticket sales, health and safety and technical requirements. Students will also learn about different ways to promote the concert and industry practise. Pupils will review the process of managing a music product and will evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of the concert with reference to the management process.
Spring Term	Unit 5: Introduction to music Performance: Pupils explore and develop their skills in practical performance on their chosen instrument/voice. Pupils will select a piece of music to develop over time, keeping a log of rehearsal and development. They will then perform the final piece on their chosen instrument.
Summer Term	Unit 5 Introduction to Music Performance: Pupils will write an evaluation of their performances from last term. Preparation for Unit 1The Music Industry: Pupils will be introduced to the different job roles in the music industry in preparation for their next unit which is externally assessed with an exam.
Homework	Pupils will have varied homework tasks this year, which will always coincide with the particular unit of work being covered in the lesson. Pupils will be set homework every single week and will be expected to complete the tasks set as an extension of the lesson.
