Dear Parent/Carers,

Following on from my communication yesterday regarding positive COVID 19 cases in Year 11 I am writing to outline arrangements that will be in place for Year 11 students from Thursday November 25th.

Following discussions with public health it has been agreed that Year 11 students will be placed in a temporary bubble until Friday December 3rd. These arrangements will be reviewed on this date and it is hoped that Year 11 students will return as normal on Monday December 6th.

The arrangements will be as follows.

Start Time 9:05am	Year 11 Students are to arrive at the school gates for 9.05am entry. Students are not to enter the school site before this time. Once students enter the site, they report to lesson 1 for a 9.15am start
9.15am	Lesson 1
9.55am	Students will be dismissed and move to lesson 2.
10am	Lesson 2
10.45am	Students will be dismissed for break. Students will be allocated the back canteen and an area which will be outside the canteen and the Muga area. This area will be clearly marked. Students will need to eat during this break.
11.30am	Students will wait for the playground to clear and move to Lesson 3.
12.25pm	Students will be dismissed and move to lesson 4
1.25pm	Students will be dismissed from the school site.
Period 5	All work relating to Period 5 will be published on Show my Homework.

The following Health and Safety Regulations will be in place for year 11 until Friday December 3rd.
